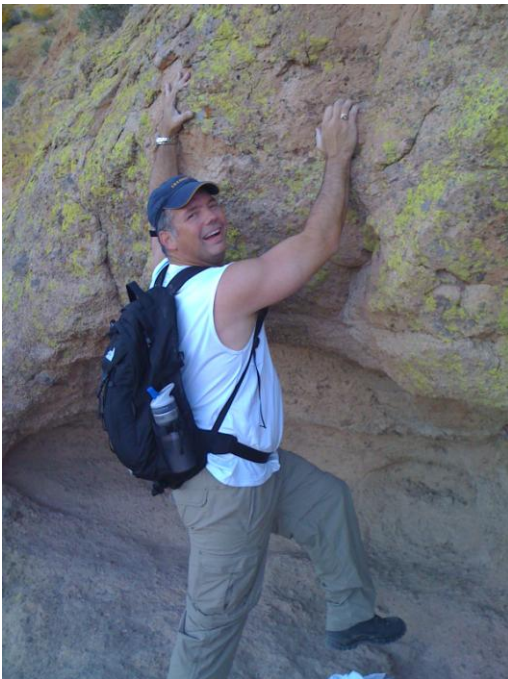

## OpenTech to Raise Funds for The Hunger Project

### *CEO Hikes Grand Canyon to Support Global Charity*

PHOENIX, Arizona (May 19, 2008) – OpenTech Alliance, Inc., has announced that Robert A.
